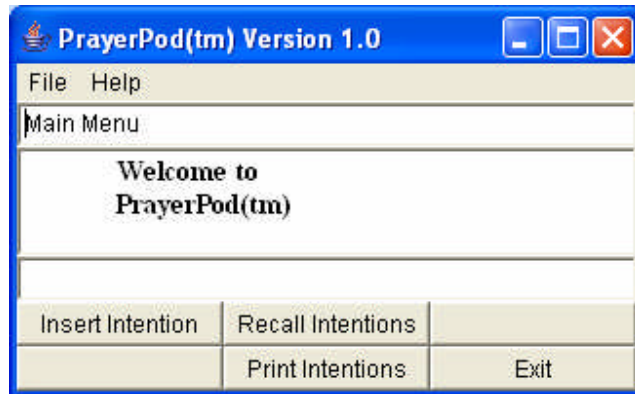


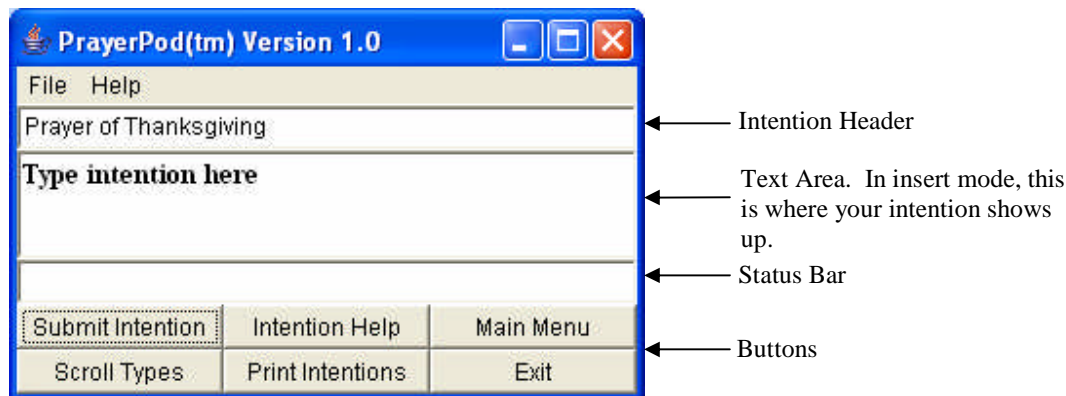
## PrayerPod™ User's Guide

Congratulations on acquiring The PrayerPod™ software application! This guide will lead you through the process of using your PrayerPod™. The tool serves two purposes; to allow you to maintain a running list of intentions, and to help guide you in possible intentions that you may not have previously thought to pray for. ### Launching PrayerPod™

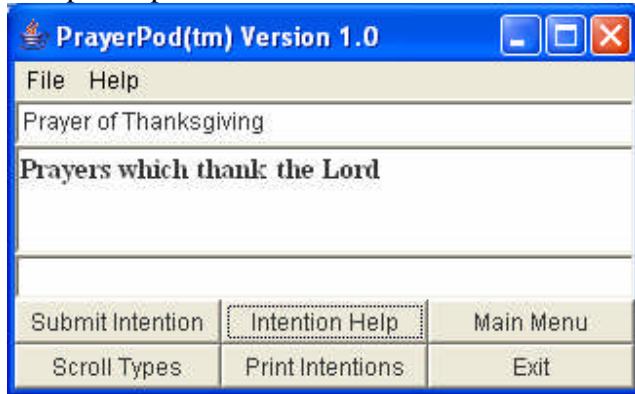
If you installed the PrayerPod™ via the setup utility for Windows, you will load the tool via the Start button by selecting “Start->Programs->MyPrayerPod->MyPrayerPod” or, if during installation you chose to create a desktop icon, by double-clicking on the PrayerPod™ icon. [Linux/Unix users launch JAR file according to OS standard] Within a few seconds, the **Main Menu** screen (shown in figure above) should appear on your screen. Four active buttons appear at the bottom of the tool: *Insert Intention*, *Recall Intentions*, *Print Intentions*, and *Exit*. *Insert Intention* and *Recall Intentions* represent the two main modes of the tool. Let’s walk through your first time use to demonstrate all the features of the tool.



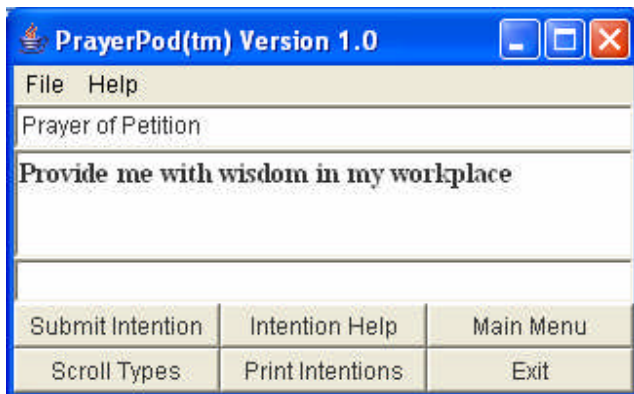
### First Time Use

The core functionality of the tool is to enter prayer intentions. To enter into *Insert* mode, select the *Insert Intentions* button from the **Main Menu** screen. The screen changes to look like the figure above. From top to bottom, the different areas of the tool are the *intention header*, *text area*, *status bar*, and *buttons*. The text “Type intention here” briefly appears (approximately 3 seconds) on the *text area* of the screen before clearing. Anything you type will appear in this area. Each intention is categorized by its type. The

default is a “Prayer of Thanksgiving.” To see a bit more about what the intention means, select **Intention Help** button. The *text area* will briefly show a description of the intention, before clearing for you to enter your intention. See figure below for an example help screen.



There are four types of prayer intentions you can enter into the PrayerPod™. To enter an intention for something other than a Prayer of Thanksgiving, select the **Scroll Types** button until you find the type you would like to add. For your first “test” intention, use the **Scroll Types** feature until the intention type Prayer of Petition appears. You should notice that as you scroll through the different prayer types, the help text for each type appears temporarily on the screen.



After the help text disappears from the text area, begin typing “Provide me with wisdom in my workplace” in the text area. Your screen should look like the figure to the left.

Now, hit the **Submit Intention** button. The intention is now part of your prayer chain, and the *Status Bar* will identify that you have successfully added intention 1.

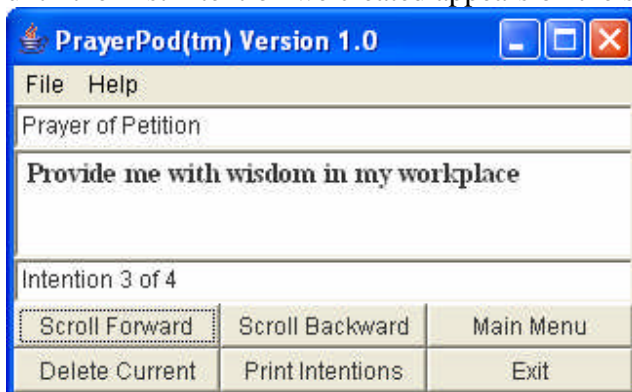
Congratulations! Now add several more intentions (do not worry yet if they are actual intentions; we’ll show you how to delete them later). Each intention can be of a different intention type. Feel free to experiment with them all!



Next, we'll take a look at the intentions we have created. Select the button for **Main Menu**, then select the button for **Recall Intentions**. The first intention in your list will appear on the screen. The list is sorted by type and alphabetically, so intention number 1 may not be the first one you entered. An example screen is to the left. Using the **Scroll Forward** and

**Scroll Backward** buttons will allow you to walk through all the intentions you have created. To create a hard-copy of the prayer list (maybe to take with you to church), select the **Print Intentions** button.

Now let's test the **Delete** capability. Use the **Scroll Forward** and **Backward** buttons until the first intention we created appears on the screen (see below).



To delete the intention that is currently displayed, select the **Delete Current** button. The intention will immediately be removed from your list, the number of total intentions will be reduced, and the screen will revert back to displaying the first intention in the list.

To return to *Insert* mode, select **Main Menu** button, then **Insert Intention** button. You can toggle back and forth between Insert and Recall mode as often as you wish. By default, the data you enter gets saved when you exit the application. When you select the **Exit** button, by default a prayer data file called *default.pry* is created in the current working directory. You can change this behavior and save the prayer data file to a named file by selecting the **File** menu bar option. Three options appear, *Load Prayer List*, *Save List As...*, and *Exit*. To create a prayer list file based on intentions inserted, select **Save List As...** and follow the system specific file selection screens. Once you have selected the *Save List As...* option, subsequently selecting *Exit* will save to the current named filename.
